This has reference to our above.

We wish to provide the details as below;

- 1. The Bank wise claim submitted by the Banks in respect of their branches operation in the state of Madhya Pradesh for the year 2010-11 & 2011-12 (till date):**

The claim submitted by Member Banks for FY 2009-10 & 2010-11, in the state of Madhya Pradesh is given in annexure-I & II respectively. The claim for the FY 2011-12 is under process and is yet to be concluded. We will be able to furnish the data for FY 2011-12 only after 30.06.2012.

- 2. Bank wise claim settled by the Canara Bank in respect of claim submitted by various banks for their branches operation in the state of Madhya Pradesh for the year 2010-11 & 2011-12 (till date):**

The claim lodged & settled for the Member Banks in the state of Madhya Pradesh is as per point no 1 above. Being a Nodal Bank, we forward the data pertaining to claim lodged by Member Banks to the Ministry of HRD and as soon as the subsidy is release by the Ministry, we release the subsidy to member Banks. All the claims lodged by Member banks are settled by Ministry of HRD.



3. Bank wise claim rejected by Canara Bank in respect of claim submitted by various Banks for their branches operating in the state of Madhya Pradesh for the Year 2010-11 and 2011-12 (till date):

As stated in point no 2 above, all the claims lodged by Member Banks are settled by Ministry of HRD. There is no rejection of claims by Ministry / Nodal Bank.

4. Bank wise claim pending with Canara Bank for settlement / reimbursement in respect of claim submitted by various Banks for their branches operating in the state of Madhya Pradesh for the Year 2010-11 and 2011-12 (till date):



There is no claim pending with Canara Bank as on date.

We further wish to inform you that Ministry of HRD (MoHRD), Government of India has extended the scheme to all Co-operative Banks which are listed in the schedule-II of RBI Act, 1934. The scheme is already applicable to the existing Member Banks of IBA i.e. Public Sector Banks, Private & foreign Banks and RRBs.

The MoHRD has permitted the member banks to lodge following claim till 30.06.2012;

- a) Supplementary claim for pending cases for FY 2009-10
- b) Supplementary claim for pending cases for FY 2010-11
- c) Primary claim for fresh cases for FY 2011-12.

We have already opened CSIS- Web portal to enable member banks to lodge their above claim. The CSIS- Web portal will remain open till 30.06.2012. The Banks who do not have USER ID & Password to access the CSIS- Web based package, can take-up the matter with us.
